Her encounter with the Reggio Emilia Approach over 20 years ago, a philosophical approach to Early Childhood Education, featured in Newsweek (1991) as one of the most progressive in the world, led to her research and thesis on how young children construct learning, and this fascination and passion have become a lifelong career focus for teaching, consulting and research. She also has had the unique and privileged experience of working alongside Reggio educators in one of the most renowned municipal preschools in Reggio Emilia, Italy.

Her research, whether in schools or other businesses, is grounded in giving value to firsthand, daily experiences from the lens of a teacher, mother, entrepreneur and lifelong learner. Through her work she continues to advocate the importance of building from the foundation of what is fundamentally important and necessary, that of people and the relationships within.

Her consultations for organizations include an array of both practical and theoretical professional development through partnerships with educational institutions including, but not limited to, hosting hands-on one-day workshops for both industry professionals and parents, designing longer term developmental programs for schools and serving as the keynote speaker at industry-wide conferences, to name a few.

Dr. Cancemi also currently serves as Board Member of Japan Institute for Reggio Emilia Alliance (JIREA) and Senior Advisor to THE CHOICE, the premier Asian women's network. She resides with her husband in Tokyo, Japan.
